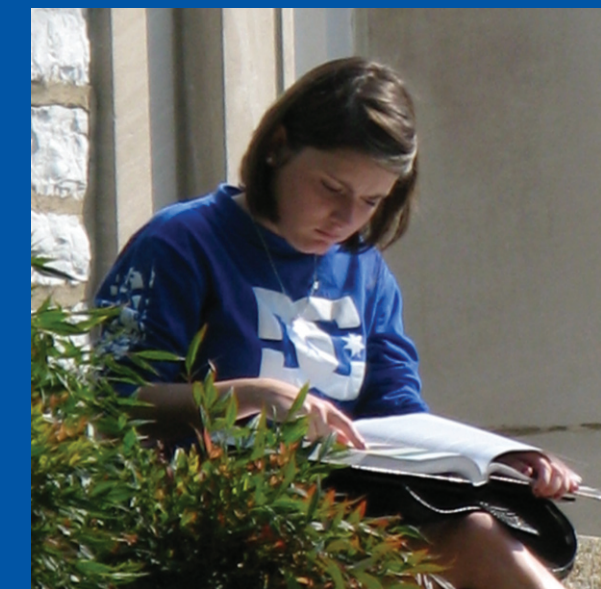

The Scholarship Program

The Cape West Rotary has teamed with Southeast Missouri State University to establish a needs based scholarship program to help students in need with the cost of their education. The scholarships are funded through sponsorships and a golf tournament.

Eligible recipients must have a financial need and must be working students. Traditional and non-traditional students are eligible. The funds can stay in your community to help local students who attend Southeast in Cape Girardeau, Kennett, Malden, Sikeston or Perryville. Every \$100,000 investment yields \$700,000 returned to the communities, and every donation means more students can receive financial help with their education.
